

The information below describes certain knowledge and skills, competencies, which graduate students should develop during their graduate career. Some competencies overlap in more than one category. Depending on your field and your chosen career path, certain competencies may be of more importance than others.

Ability to strategically plan and set goals and milestones. Ability to lead a group, create a vision, build a sense of purpose, and motivate a group regardless of their race, gender, sexual orientation or religious affiliation. Ability to define a problem and devise solutions with sensitivity to the context. Ability to provide constructive criticism.
